The Boulder International Fringe Festival is seeking individuals to serve on its board of directors. The BIFF is a non-profit organization that guides a dynamic, independent arts festival packed with everything from live theatre and dance to circus art, site-specific performance, music, film, and educational workshops. Our 2010 lineup features performers from as far as Brazil and Germany, fresh new acts from Chicago and Los Angeles, and several returning artists and local favorites. From August 18th to the 29th, these performers will take over Boulder spaces from standard theaters to coffee shops, churches, museums and bars. The Fringe is a priceless opportunity for these independent artists to produce their own work with 100% creative freedom--and they keep 100% of their box office. 20,000 audience members from all over the Front Range attend 300 Fringe shows in just 12 days. In addition, the Fringe is an invaluable year-round resource for artists, serving as co-producer on new works and community events.

Board members attend monthly board meetings (currently on the 2nd Thursday of the month); support the executive director and his staff; help with fundraising; monitor the finances of the organization; and otherwise help the BIFF to be the best it can be.
